


About Us

Applicants must be a high school chemistry educator teaching in a U.S. or U.S. territory school.

Application Deadline: May 1

Applicant Decision Date: Mid-July

Eligibility

To be eligible, you must:

- Have a Bachelor's degree or higher in chemistry or a chemistry-related discipline
- Have less than one year of work experience outside of obtaining undergraduate and graduate degrees**
- Demonstrate interest and commitment to becoming a secondary educator
- Be accepted into an education master's program or a teacher certification program
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident

* Due to scholarship guidelines, scholarship stipends are distributed in equal installments two times per academic year. This may result in scholars receiving half of their total scholarship if they complete their program by the Fall semester.
